**Open to all. Includes optional course round ditch. Will include water jump.
Rosettes for all who complete the course & additional rosettes to 6th place.**

Class 2 – Group 3 – 2'9" **1.30pm – 2.30pm**

**Open to all. Includes ditch, steps & water jump.
Rosettes for all who complete the course & additional rosettes to 6th place.**

Entry Fee: £14.00 Juniors/£17.00 Seniors (16yrs+)

Entries close Tuesday 30th August.

Scoring:

All rounds will be timed against the clock.

Time penalties will be added for knockdowns and refusals.

Knockdown 20 seconds

Refusal 50 Seconds

Fall of Horse/Rider Elimination

Course time (including penalties) decides placing. If the rider opts for the joker fence (last fence on course) , and does so successfully, the rider time will be reduced by 40 seconds and, conversely, increased by 40 seconds if a knockdown occurs.

All riders must wear body protectors and hats to current standard, and medical armband on the day.

Medical armbands can be purchased from Priory Court Farm for £5.00 (prior to the competition day only).

Rules & Conditions of Entry

- 1) The organisers of JumpCross and Priory Court Farm reserve the right to: Refuse entry without stating a reason, eliminate at any time during the competition any horse which, in the opinion of the steward, is unfit, ill or injured, and cancel the event or any class.
- 2) All riders must wear body protectors and hats to current standard and medical armband when competing.
Hats: BSI Kite Marked PAS 015, BSEN 1384 or ASTM 1163, must be worn at all times when mounted with chinstrap fastened.
- 3) A fall of horse/rider results in Elimination. The rider must leave the course Un-mounted, and report to the Medical professional and organisers, prior to leaving the showground.
- 4) During the competition, no person will be allowed on the course without the controller's authority, other than in the stated spectator's areas. No dogs are allowed on the course during the running of the competition. At all other times, dogs must be kept on a lead and any fouling cleared away.
- 5) All animals and children to be kept under control at all times.
- 6) The organisers accept no responsibility or liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to any competitor, horse, spectator or cars and property, whether caused by negligence or any other way arising from this event.
- 7) All competitors participate at their own risk. The competitor should satisfy him/herself that they are, and their horse is competent to attempt all jumps. Everyone must take reasonable care to avoid and prevent accidents, and must obey all rules and instructions of officials at all times. The organisers have taken all precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone who uses the course.
- 8) Any person to be seen riding dangerously will be asked to leave the course. Excessive use of whips/spurs will not be allowed. No draw reins/market harboroughs.
- 9) There is a paramedic on site to provide pre-hospital treatment during this event if required. All competitors confirm that they are fit to compete, and that they consent to any treatment which may be given, advised or offered by the paramedic.
- 10) All cars and horseboxes to be parked in designated areas. All areas must be left tidy. Please do not muck out boxes on site, and take your litter home with you.
- 11) Events are being photographed, and by attending you are giving permission for both JumpCross and Priory Court Farm to use these images without exception. Only the official JumpCross photographer is permitted to sell images of this event.
- 12) The judge's decision is final.

Acceptance of the above rules shall be a condition of entry.
